## Headwaters Golf Club (HGC) Women's 18 Hole Golf League

#### League Membership:

- The HGC women's 18-hole league continues weekly on Tuesdays from May through mid-September. Tee times generally start between 11:30am-12:30pm each week.
- The league is open to all players, both members of HGC and those who are greens fees payers. Players may join the league at any point in the season.
- League members pay an annual fee (no more than \$30) which covers weekly prizes and other costs of conducting the league.
- League members sign up by 3 pm Monday to participate Tuesday of that week. The sign-up sheet is posted outside the upstairs ladies room. (There is no obligation to play each week. Play when you are able.)
- The club manager makes the pairings each week and emails them to league members by mid-morning on Tuesdays.

#### The Course:

- HGC is an 18-hole course with a pro-shop and snack bar in the clubhouse. There are red (5300 yds), green (4300 yds) and combo (5000 yds) tees for women to choose from.
- The driving range is free at all times to members of HGC. League members who are not also HGC members must pay for range balls.
- Bathrooms are located on holes #5/8 and also near the 15th green. The crossover hole near the clubhouse is between Holes #12-13, not after Hole #9.
- The first 14 holes have a rolling terrain, while the last four holes are quite hilly.
- Non-HGC members pay the 18-hole Resort Fee for greens fees. This discounted rate is for league play only.
   Riding carts and pull carts may also be rented through the pro shop. League members who wish to walk 12 and ride the back 6 may rent a cart for \$6 at the turn.

### Rules/Handicap:

- The league plays USGA and summer rules except where noted during special events.
- Each league player must have a current GHIN membership and established handicap. Any league member who does not have a GHIN membership may establish one through HGC for an additional fee. A league member without a GHIN handicap may play in league but is not eligible for prizes until a handicap is established.
- The HGC staff post each week's scores onto the league members' GHIN records.

### Weekly Games:

- In addition to the regular 18-hole play each week, there is a special game which might be an individual or a team event. The game is emailed out to the league along with the pairings and tee times for that week.
- Also each week, league members may choose to enter the closest to the pin (#3), birdies, and chip-ins contests.
   To enter those events, league members put \$.25 into the appropriate bowls and sign the contest sheet in the snack bar prior to teeing off. Winners share the entry money for that week.

#### Special Events:

- Monthly league meeting The last Tuesday of each month there is a league meeting immediately following golf for that day. There is also a special meal prepared by the snack bar. Sign-up for the meeting and meal is the prior week.
- Connect For The Cause Each year the HGC women's league holds a Connect For The Cause fundraiser for the
  Essentia Health Foundation. 100% of funds raised go to support local cancer patients and their families,
  generally in the form of gas and/or hotel vouchers which are not covered by insurance.

# Women's Leagues

- Pairings are chosen by a ball draw. Arrive a half hour before tee time to socialize and allow time to create pairings.
- League membership dues are \$30. Money goes towards weekly prizes.
- Each player also puts in \$.25 each play day that goes into a pot which is given to the players who chip in during the game.
- The Club offers a lunch special after play which is a fun time to socialize.

# Women's 18 Hole League

- Tee times start at 11:30 or noon.
- Each player must establish a handicap before she is eligible to win game prizes.
   If new to the league, you can play as a social player until your handicap is established.
- Sign-up by 3:00pm Monday to participate in the following Tuesday's game.
- Pairings are created by the club manager. Participants play with different players each week. Pairings, tee times, and the day's game are sent by email midmorning Tuesday by the club manager.
- League membership dues are a maximum of \$30. Money goes towards weekly prizes.

- Players may choose to enter the closest to the pin (hole #3), birdies, and chip-ins contests. To enter those events, players put \$.25 into the appropriate bowls prior to teeing off. Winners share the entry money for that week.
- Players may play from their prefered tee. There are red (5300 yds), green (4300 yds) and combo (5000 yds) tees from which to choose.
- Stay for a drink and socialize following play. A league meeting is held the last Tuesday of the month and a special dinner is offered by the Club.
